

CANADA "Acceptable" Anti-stripping Asphalt Hot Mix and Warm Mix Additives for 2025 NS Department of Public Works Paving Projects

The products on this list have been subjected to an internal Occupational Health and Safety Review by NSDPW respecting formulation and the toxicology of ingredients and have been determined to meet departmental criteria for use on 2025 paving projects. Inclusion on this list indicates that the product has been reviewed with respect to potential health effects on workers who may be exposed to it during asphalt hot or warm mix plant, spreading and compacting operations. Their use is governed by the NSDPW 2025 Action Plan for the Use of Liquid Anti-stripping Asphalt Additives on NSDPW Projects.
